LECTURERS

Michael Depaolis, O.D.

Dr. Michael DePaolis is a graduate of the Pennsylvania College of Optometry and has practiced in the Rochester community since 1987. He serves as adjunct faculty at the Pennsylvania College of Optometry and is a Clinical Associate in Ophthalmology at the University of Rochester, School of Medicine. A Fellow in the Academy of Optometry and the Editor of Primary Care Optometry News, Dr. DePaolis frequently serves as a clinical investigator in the disciplines of contact lenses and anterior segment care. The author of over 100 articles, papers and textbook chapters, he has lectured at over 400 eye care meetings worldwide.

Gary Andrasko, O.D.

Dr. Andrasko received his Optometry degree from The Ohio State University in 1978 and a Masters degree in Physiological Optics in 1980. He was a faculty member at the OSU College of Optometry from 1980 to 1990. Currently he is the director of a private contact lens clinical research practice in Columbus, OH. Areas of current interest include hydrogel lens end of day comfort and dryness, corneal physiological response to hydrogel solutions, and solution biocompatibility with various silicone/hydrogel materials. He has over 50 publications and is also the publisher of the www.StainingGrid.com website.

Richard A. Erdey, M.D.

Dr. Erdey is a cataract, corneal and refractive specialist and is board certified. His training included an ophthalmology residency at North Shore Cornell Medical Center where he was chief resident. He then did a Cornea Fellowship at The Ohio State University and subsequently co-directed the Cornea Research Laboratory at The University of Rochester. He reestablished his practice in Columbus in 1992, and is currently the Medical Director at both the Erdey Searcy Eye Group and East Columbus Surgery Center.
